Genome Science 2017

The Genome Science meeting started out life as the UK Next Generation Sequencing meeting in Nottingham, and has since evolved and grown to be a successful event attracting 250 delegates each year. This meeting represents a fantastic opportunity for both academia and industry to engage, sharing advances, innovations and challenges in working with omics data.

Genome 10K 2017

Genome 10K is a community of scientists with a common interest in sequencing the genomes of over ten thousand vertebrate species to increase understanding of a wider variety of species and to support conservation efforts globally. The community of scientists involved in this initiative continues to have strength in numbers, with the last meeting in 2015 attracting 150 scientists from around the world.



Conference Centre
